

HOMELESS MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (HMIS)

The Stanislaus County Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) is a collaborative project of the Stanislaus Community System of Care (CSOC) on Affordable Housing and Homelessness. It is administered by the Stanislaus County Community Services Agency as the HMIS Lead Agency. Stanislaus County HMIS is a secure online database used by organizations that provide services to people who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. HMIS data enables the CSOC to collect uniform, client-level, system-wide information over time and analyze and adapt strategies to meet the needs of people experiencing homelessness in our community.
